It is fine if you choose to leave your bulls with us to feed and deliver at a later date, but please rememsale day. ber that we cannot be responsible for any injury or death which may occur during that time. We encourage you to obtain insurance on your purchases at the clerk's desk sale day. We stand behind our bulls and are anxious to hear how they perform for you. If you have any problems we want to know so that we can solve them.

For the first time we will broadcast our auction live on RFD-TV through Superior Livestock. The details for this may be found on page 71 of this booklet and we are excited about how this service will make it even easier for our customers to purchase cattle here.
